"And you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free." (John 8:32) Two key words jump out of that simple verse, don't they? What "truth" is Jesus referring to, and what is the "freedom" He promises? I remember flipping through television channels on a ministry trip and watching a performer sing, "What is truth?", over and over again. I practically shouted at the tv, "It's Jesus!". And of course, it is. Jesus said He is the way, the TRUTH and the life. We also know God's word, the Bible, is the unfailing, inerrant, truth as well. (John 14:6, 17:17). When we commit our lives to Jesus, His Holy Spirit opens our hearts to His word, and we can understand truth. Not the ever-changing "truth" of the world, but real, unchanging truth!

May we and our nation once again fix our eyes on Jesus and live in true, Christ-centered freedom!
